SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located at the lower clubhouse.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Any changes to the sailing instructions will be posted within 15 minutes of the Competitors Information Meeting.

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

4.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed on the flagpole, west of the lower clubhouse.

4.2 When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 15 minutes' in race signal AP.

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

5.1 A competitors' meeting will be held at 1000 hrs.

5.2 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race for the

- Junior Start will be at 1045 hrs.
- Single Handed Monohull 1050
- Double Handed Monohull 1055
- Opti Start will be at 1100
- Multihull (Adult) start will be at 1105

5.3 Following races shall be held as soon as possible after the preceding race.

5.4 No race shall be started after 1600 hrs.

6. CLASS FLAGS

6.1 Juniors – Number Pennant 5

6.2 Single handed monohulls – Numeral Pennant 1

6.3 Double handed monohulls – Numeral Pennant 2

6.4 Optimist – Number Pennant 4

6.5 Multihulls – Numeral Pennant 3

7. THE COURSES

- 7.1 Courses will be per CYC Thursday Night race instructions as posted on the notice board
- 7.2 Triangle or sausage symbols indicating the course to be sailed will be displayed on the committee boat with or before the preparatory signal of the class about to start. This changes rule 27.1.

8. MARKS

- 8.1 Marks of the course will be round, orange marks.
- 8.2 The start/finish mark will be a spar.

9. THE START

- 9.1 Races will be started by using rule 26 with the warning signal given 5 minutes before the starting signal.
- 9.2 The start will be between the RC flag on the committee boat and a spar at the port-end of the start line.
- 9.3 A boat starting later than 4 minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start. This changes rule A4.1.

10. THE FINISH

- 10.1 The finish line will be between a staff displaying the RC flag on the committee boat and a spar.

11. TIME LIMITS

- 11.1 There will be a 75 minute time limit for the first boat in any class to finish.
- 11.2 Boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Did Not Finish. This changes rules 35 and A4.1.

12. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- 12.1 Protest forms are available at the race office. Protests shall be delivered there within the protest time limit.
- 12.2 Protest time will begin 5 minutes after the final competitor arrives at shore. Protest time shall last 10 minutes. No signal of the protest period shall be made.

13. SCORING

- 13.1 One race must be completed to constitute a series.
- 13.2 For Club championship single handed monohulls, double handed monohulls, and multihulls shall be scored separately.

14. SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 14.1 All entrants shall to wear a life jacket at all times while on the water. This amends RRS 40.

15. PRIZES

- 15.1 Trophy and prizes shall be awarded at the annual banquet.
