2016 Alberta Sailing Association Provincial Regatta And Western Canadian Masters

1. RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RSS).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. The ASA Provincial Regatta is open to all dinghy and catamaran classes.

2.2. Registration is available online at <http://calgaryyachtclub.wildapricot.org/event-2290723/Registration>

2.3. Participants are encouraged to register online and in advance. A late registration fee of \$10 will be charged for onsite registrations.

3. FLEETS

Five or more boats of the same class registered by 09:00 hours on Saturday, September 3 will constitute a class. All other boats will sail in open classes divided at the discretion of the Race Officer. For open class racing, boat times will be adjusted using the current wind adjusted Portsmouth ratings. The Optimist fleet may be further divided into classes based on experience level at the discretion of the Optimist Race Officer.

4. FEES

The required fees are as follows:

Single Handed Boat	\$60
Double Handed Boat	\$75
Triple Handed Boat	\$90

5. MEALS

5.1. Complimentary Continental breakfast will be served each morning.

5.2. For Saturday, a bag lunch will be provided and is included in the entry fee

5.3. **Louisiana Seafood Boil** Dinner on Saturday and Lunch on Sunday will be available at an additional cost:

Lunch \$12, Dinner \$30 (adult) - \$20 (youth)

6. SCHEDULE

On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 1400.

7. VENUE

The Regatta will take place at the Calgary Yacht Club Chestermere, Alberta, 20 km east of Calgary Alberta. The race area will be on Chestermere Lake.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 8.1. A link to the sailing instructions will be sent out with the registration confirmation.
- 8.2. Sailing Instructions will be provided for the onsite registrants.

9. COURSES

The course will be of the windward/leeward type with a Hollywood finish.

10. SAFETY

Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices, at all times when afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. This changes the Part 4 preamble.

11. AWARDS

Prizes shall be awarded as follows:

- 1-3 boats in a fleet, 1st place shall be awarded;
- 4-6 boats in a fleet, 1st and 2nd places shall be awarded,
- 7+ boats in a fleet, 1st, 2nd and 3rd places shall be awarded

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4. Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

13. RIGHTS TO USE NAME AND LIKENESS

In participating in an event, a competitor automatically grants to the Organizing Authority and the sponsors of the event, the right in perpetuity, to make, use and show, from time to time and at their discretion, any motion pictures, still pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him/her during the period of the competition in this event in which the competitor participates and in all material related to the events without compensation.
